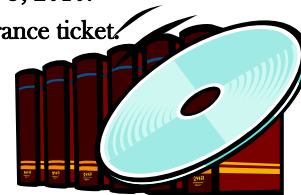
Where is Genealogy Software Headed?

Dick Eastman has been involved in genealogy more than 30 years; computers, more than 40. In the '70's, he used a mainframe and punch cards to enter family data, building his first home computer in 1980.

In the mid-'80s, Dick went knocking on the CompuServe door to propose a genealogy forum: a move by which he built a community of family historians over the next 14 years.

In late 1995, Dick expressed his interest in creating a weekly newsletter to be e-mailed to genealogists all over the world. On January 15, 1996, Dick and Pam Cerutti launched Eastman's Online Genealogy Newsletter as an e-mail publication, announcing it to 100 very surprised friends and acquaintances.

The newsletter has since grown into a daily publication read by more than 40,000 genealogists all over the world. It comes in both a free version and the paid subscription "Plus" Edition.
